They were great in having us to critically think and good in getting us in experiences that they could. Have more contracts with different hospitals. Like magnet hospitals or Aspirus.

- I don't really know. I work at Mayo Clinic Health Systems now and I believe I was taught the appropriate skills I need for my entry level job I got at Mayo Clinic. The skills that I needed to start out at a entry level hospital nurse. I am a surgical nurse. Blood transfusions, nasal gastric tube insertion, and maintenance of them. Catheter insertion, medication administration. We have a little different computer system but just getting used to charting telemetry and any of that stuff. Not really.
