SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- This application is for London International Study (January 2-13, 2017) or Guatemala International Study (December 29, 2016 – January 15, 2017).
- There are four \$300 scholarships available. Priority will be given to students who have not received an International Study scholarship previously. Students who may have received other Foundation scholarships are still eligible to apply.
- Academic Standing Requirements: A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA is required. If your transcript does not show a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA, you will not be considered.
- All areas of the application must be completed. Applications are evaluated on a point system and failure to follow directions exactly may result in lower point totals. Complete, thorough, and specific answers to the essay question will earn higher points. If you have questions call Heather Schallock, Foundation Executive Director, at 715-365-4518.

SECTION I

Academic Standing Requirement - 15 points

All students must submit their most recent transcript to the Foundation Office with this application. Students must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA to be eligible for a scholarship award. Applications submitted with a transcript showing less than a 2.5 cumulative GPA and applications submitted without a transcript will not be considered.

- You can obtain your transcript by going to www.nicoletcollege.edu and click the My Nicolet icon. Enter your student ID and password in the My Nicolet Sign-in Box. In the Academic History box, click "View my Transcript." Click the drop down arrow in the "Report Type" box and select "Unofficial Transcript." Click "View Report." A red processing message will display and the report will appear. If a report does not appear, click the pop-up ribbon at the top of the page and allow pop-ups from the site. Print the transcript. If you have difficulty navigating through My Nicolet to get your transcript, contact the Nicolet Student Help Desk at 715-365-4478. The transcript you print will not be "official", but it is acceptable for the scholarship application. If you have difficulty in obtaining your transcript via My Nicolet, you can request one at the Welcome Center. Write on the form that the transcript is needed for the scholarship application. You will be charged a fee if you wait until the last day to request your transcript.
- If you have not attended Nicolet for at least one semester, you must submit your most recent transcript from high school or another college showing at least a 2.5 GPA. If you have any questions, please call 715-365-4518.

All applicants will be notified by mail whether or not they have received a scholarship. Letters will be sent on or before September 30, 2016.

All applications must be signed and dated.

All of the information on this application is true to the best of my knowledge.

I understand that if I receive a scholarship, I am required to write a thank-you letter to the donor and send a copy to the Foundation within one month of receiving my award letter. If these requirements are not met, the scholarship will not be awarded.
