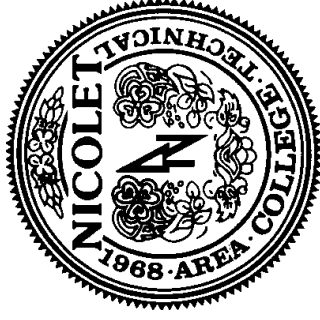

OPENING JULY 27, 2010

Open to all artists 18 years or older who are US residents. Each artist may submit slides or jpgs of recent, original, 2D hang-able work of any medium including photography. Entries must both be in the same format. (slide or jpg)

A non-refundable fee of \$30.00 will entitle the artist to submit either one or two images -- ONE image per art work. Images must accurately represent the work entered. Make checks payable to Nicolet College.

Label SLIDES with artist's name, title, medium, dimensions and top indicated. Place red dot in lower left corner.

DIGITAL IMAGES must be PC-compatible jpg files no larger than 300 dpi at approximately 4 x 6 inches. Label each image in this format: (last name)_(First initial)_(Title)_(Entry #).jpg

Example: Johnson_M_BlueSky_2.jpg

NO Kodak or Walmart etc. 'Easy Share' files.

JUROR/JUDGE: Larry McNeil

Larry McNeil teaches all levels of photography, including digital imaging, at Boise State College in Idaho. McNeil is originally from Juneau, Alaska and his MFA is from the University of New Mexico. His work has been exhibited throughout the Americas and Europe, including at the Center for Creative Photography in Manhattan, the San Diego Museum of Art and in the Migrations: New Directions in Native American Art project which was recently at Keene College. He has been a guest lecturer at the Barbican Gallery in London, The Museum of Anthropology at the University of British Columbia and the Smithsonian in Washington, D.C. McNeil has earned various fellowships and awards including the 'New Works Award' from the national photography organization En Foco. He has been Co-Chair of the Boise State University First Nations Conference and is Vice President of the Boise State University Cultural and Ethnic Diversity Board.

Prizes and Awards Three \$1,000 Awards of Excellence Over \$8,500 in Prize Money

Awards will be made from the actual art works. Work must be at the Nicolet Gallery by July 17 and remain for the entire exhibition. All proceeds of sales will be assigned to the artist. Prize money will be distributed after the close of the show.

Additional Specifications and Guidelines: The gallery reserves the privilege of deleting from the exhibition any work that does not conform to the entry specifications or that involves possible copyright infringement.

Every precaution will be taken in handling and exhibiting works.
