
## **Instructions for Clearing Java Cache (Windows and MAC)**

## To Clear Java Plug-In Cache (Windows - All Versions)

- 1. Click Start > Control Panel.
- 2. Double-click the Java icon in the control panel. The Java Control Panel appears.



3. Click Settings under Temporary Internet Files. The Temporary Files Settings dialog box appears.



4. Click Delete Files. The Delete Temporary Files dialog box appears.



- 5. Click **OK** on **Delete Temporary Files** window. This deletes all the Downloaded Applications and Applets from the cache.
- 6. Click **OK** on **Temporary Files Settings** window. **Note:** If you want to delete a specific application and applet form the cache, click on View Application and View Applet options respectively.

## To Clear Java Plug-In Cache (MAC OS x 10.5 (Leopard), 10.6 (Snow Leopard), 10.7 (Lion) and Java 1.5 and 1.6)


1. Click on the **Finder** icon located in your dock.




- 2. Click **Applications** and then click the **Utilities** folder.
- 3. Double-click the Java Preferences icon.



Click on the tab labeled Network and then click the button labeled Delete Files.



5. Ensure that both check boxes are checked and then click the **OK** button.



6. Close the Java Control Panel.
