Biennial Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention Program Review (August 2016)

The College has few incidents of alcohol and drug use reported or observed annually. Much of this can be attributed to the fact that we are a commuter campus. During the 2014-15 academic years, there were reports of individuals who were of age who had an odor of intoxicants in violation of our standards of conduct policy. We dealt with these incidents and found that the individuals were not intoxicated. We did advise them that they cannot be in our classes while being under the influence of intoxicants. We did not have any incidents involving underage individuals or employees.

The College reviews the Alcohol and Drug Use policy (AP 4.05) on an annual basis taking all reported incidents into account. To allow for early intervention, the College has also instituted a reasonable suspicion process for employees of the College. The College has a very effective response and referral process. There is no need at this time to modify any of those activities.
