<i>Educational Requirements for 10-level General Education English courses:</i>	<p>Bachelor's degree in English, Literature, Reading, Journalism, Speech, Communication Studies or closely related discipline is required.</p> <p>Additionally:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If teaching Literature courses, have a minor or eighteen semester credits in English or Literature.• If teaching Writing courses, have a minor or eighteen semester credits in English or Journalism.• If teaching Communicative Skills courses, must have a minor or eighteen semester credits in any combination of English, Journalism, Speech (not Drama or Theater) or Communication Studies.
<i>Educational Requirements for 20-level Liberal Arts English courses:</i>	<p>Master's degree in English, Literature, Communication Studies or a closely related field is required. Additionally:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If teaching Literature courses, have eighteen graduate credits in English or Literature.• If teaching Writing courses, have eighteen graduate credits in English, Journalism, Technical Reporting or Creative Writing.• If teaching Communicative Skills courses, have eighteen graduate credits in any combination of English, Journalism, Speech (not Drama or Theater) or Communication.
