Educational Requirements:	Bachelor's degree in Manufacturing, Engineering, or a closely related field required. Occupational Requirements:	Two years (4,000 hours) of verified occupational work experience as a maintenance mechanic is required. Experience must be in manufacturing or related occupations. Occupational experience must include one year (2,000 hours) within the past five years. Recent teaching experience in post-secondary higher education may substitute for up to one year of the occupational experience requirement. Additional experience in manufacturing outside the field of education preferred.
