

FACULTY QUALIFICATIONS FOR OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAMS

Instructional Area:	543 Nursing Assistant
Educational Requirements:	Associate's degree in Nursing is required. A DHS Primary instructor course completed for Nursing Assistant instruction is required.
Occupational Requirements:	Two years (4,000 hours) of verified occupational work experience as a registered nurse is required. Experience must be as an RN . Occupational experience must include one year (2,000 hours) within the past five years with medical/surgical/and/or geriatric experience required. A minimum of one year experience in long term care is required.
Working titles which provide the occupational experience necessary to function as an instructor:	 Registered Nurse Staff Nurse Head Nurse Nursing Supervisor Charge Nurse Nurse Practitioner Nurse Clinician Nurse Manager
Relevant job duties an individual should have performed:	 Personal care of patients (including bathing, oral hygiene, nail care, shaving, shampooing, dressing/undressing). Maintenance of the patient's environment (safety and cleanliness, managing linens, dishes/supplies, making of bedoccupied and unoccupied).
