How can emergency financial assistance help?

Forms of emergency financial assistance can include:

- Gas cards
- Utility bills
- Automotive repairs
- Childcare costs
- Past due rent
- Books & class supplies
- Tuition Assistance
- Food Assistance

How do I apply?

The [application](#) can be found online in MyNicolet under the financial tab. A paper version is in the document center, which can be returned to the Welcome Center. Students may be asked to provide additional documentation, depending on their financial request.

What else is important to know?

- Funding is not guaranteed. Students must have a complete and current FAFSA on file with Nicolet.
- Students should expect to hear back on Emergency Financial Assistance applications and their next steps within 72 hours. Timelines depend upon the request and if any additional documentation is required.
