**Courses equivalent to the UWSP requirements may be completed at Nicolet resulting in a 3+1 program.*

The UWSP SHCP advisor will work with students on an individual basis to assure students' needs are met and to guide students in the appropriate selection of courses.

Special Considerations:

1. A minimum GPA of 2.5 must have been earned at Nicolet College.
2. Course credit will be awarded only if a grade of C or better has been earned in the nursing courses at Nicolet.
3. Course credit for 10-806-177, 10-806-179, and 10-806-197 will only be awarded if a grade of C or better has been earned.
4. The acceptance of Nicolet credits applies only to students who have successfully completed the State of Wisconsin RN License Exam.
5. The acceptance of credits applies only this program-to-program articulation.
6. For acceptance of equivalent courses, Nicolet courses must have been completed in 1996 or later. Prior to this period, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
