*Courses equivalent to the UWSP requirements may be completed at Nicolet resulting in a 3+1 program.

The UWSP SHCP advisor will work with students on an individual basis to assure students' needs are met and to guide students in the appropriate selection of courses.

Special Considerations:

- 1. A minimum GPA of 2.5 must have been earned at Nicolet College.
- 2. Course credit will be awarded only if a grade of C or better has been earned in the nursing courses at Nicolet.
- 3. Course credit for 10-806-177, 10-806-179, and 10-806-197 will only be awarded if a grade of C or better has been earned.
- 4. The acceptance of Nicolet credits applies only to students who have successfully completed the State of Wisconsin RN License Exam.
- 5. The acceptance of credits applies only this this program-to-program articulation.
- 6. For acceptance of equivalent courses, Nicolet courses must have been completed in 1996 or later. Prior to this period, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
