- Education majors are admitted as Pre-Education. Acceptance into the UW-Stout professional program is based upon academic and non-academic criteria determined by the School of Education.
 - Admission to UW-Stout does NOT guarantee admission to the professional program in the UW-Stout School of Education. Students need to have completed and/or met all the following before applying:
 1. Completed 40 semester credit hours at an accredited college with a 2.5 GPA (6 credits earned at UW-Stout)
 2. Earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 at UW-Stout
 3. Passed the National Background check - Good for 3 years
 4. Passed Pre-Professional Skills Test OR CORE test (effective Fall 2014) OR have acceptable ACT, SAT or GRE scores that are no more than five years old from the time you enroll in your program.
 5. "C" or better in ENGL 101 & 102 and COMST 100.
 6. Completed/currently enrolled in Intro to major course ("C" or better)
 7. Completed/currently enrolled in EDUC 326 Foundations of Education ("C" or better)
 8. Satisfactory completion of Benchmark I:
 - Satisfactorily completed Philosophy of Education for portfolio*
 - Satisfactorily completed resume for portfolio*
 - Satisfactory rating on Disposition Assessment by Faculty*
 - Satisfactorily completed artifacts and reflection evidences for electronic portfolio*
 - Satisfactory rating on Student Interview I
