

Nicolet College District Board Opening

The Board Appointment Committee is accepting applications for one (1) position on the Nicolet College District Board. Applications are due by 4 pm on Friday, May 5, 2023.

Rules governing the appointment process can be found in Wisconsin State Statutes 38.08 & 38.10. Appointments will be made for the following positions in accordance with the Board Appointment Committee's Plan of Representation, which specifies categories of membership as well as geographic areas, gender, and minority representation within the district. In order to meet the Plan of Representation, the following open positions and requirements must be filled.

Open Position:

The following position will commence on or about July 11, 2023, upon certification by the Wisconsin Technical College System Board.

- **One (1) Interim Employer Member** - The position will expire on June 30, 2025

Of the Current Openings:

- Applicant must reside in Oneida County or the portion of Langlade County that is within the Nicolet College District.
- Applicant must meet the board member category definition for an Employer Member (below).

Board Member Category Definitions:

Employer Member: To qualify as an employer, you must receive earnings as payment for your service and possess the power to hire, transfer, suspend, layoff, recall, promote, discharge, assign, reward, or discipline other employees or adjust employee grievances or effectively recommend such action if in connection with the exercise of such power the person exercises independent judgment in relation to the power. An employer does not include a person acting in the capacity of officer or agent of a labor organization. At the time of their appointment, employers also must be actively engaged in business and employ others.

In the appointment process, equal consideration is given to the general population distribution within the Nicolet College District, as well as to the distribution of women and minorities. *Note: No two members of the Nicolet College District Board may be officials of the same governmental unit, nor may any district board member be a member of the school board which employs the School District Administrator member.*

Notarized affidavit (application) forms must be received at the address below no later than **Friday, May 5, 2023, at 4 p.m.** Applicants must participate in the board appointment meeting and public hearing of the District Board Appointment Committee on Wednesday, May 17, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. To accommodate any candidates unable to attend on this date to be interviewed, a second meeting and public hearing are scheduled for Thursday, May 18, 2023 at 3 p.m. (if needed).

Meetings will be in-person with a virtual option. Candidates will need to provide at least two letters of recommendation supporting his/her candidacy to the Nicolet College District Board before being interviewed at the scheduled public hearing.
