## Teacher Education Program (TED) Admission Process

The following must be successfully completed before a student may be admitted to the Teacher Education Program:

- Completion of TED 200 with grade B or higher and completion of TED 100 with at least a P.
- A grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 on at least 40 semester credits of collegiate-level course work including transfer credit as calculated by the Honors GPA.
- Submission of completed application by March 1/October 1/August 1, which includes a criminal background check.


## Additional Requirements for the Elementary Education Program and

 LicensureThe following must be successfully completed for program completion and licensure:

- Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA as calculated by the Honors GPA.
- Completion of all courses with the Elementary Education major and Instruction minor with a minimum grade of C , except TED 200 where a minimum grade of $B$ is required and TED 100 where a $P$ is required.
- Passing score on the Praxis Middle School Content Knowledge assessment.
- All students are required to pass the Foundations of Reading Test prior to licensure.
- Satisfactory completion of student teaching residency.

Students planning to transfer should work closely with their Nicolet Success Coach and transfer personnel at UW Superior for the most current information.
