Admission into the UWW College of Education Professional Education Program is based upon the student's successful completion of academic and nonacademic criteria determined by the College of Education and Professional Studies. These criteria are as follows (also available on the Admission to Professional Education website):

- Completion of 30 degree credits (transferable credits and UWW credits).
- 2.75 combined cumulative grade point average on transferable credits, or Completion of an approved AAS or AA degree in Early Childhood Education, or Qualifying test scores.
- Completed applications and test scores (if applicable) must be submitted by the posted deadlines on the COEPS Admission webpage.

Students planning to transfer should work closely with their Nicolet Success Coach and transfer personnel at UW Whitewater for the most current information.
