

an award like this inspires the entire team."



Becoming a Family

Dr. Kricket Koehn and Alex Tomasoski credit Nicolet College for their success, but these two alumni also found love on campus. "He was studying physics, so I just asked if I could sit down and study with him," Kricket recalls.

Alex Tomasoski graduated from Three Lakes High School in 2010 and started attending Michigan Technological University. Feeling overwhelmed, he decided to take time to figure out what he really wanted to do, and after one year, transferred to Nicolet College.

Kricket Koehn graduated from Rhinelander High School in 2011 and also enrolled in the University Transfer program at Nicolet College.

It's here where they worked toward their college degrees, all while falling in love. Alex says, "I remember we were going on break, we exchanged phone numbers and started spending some more time together and we were going to make it long-term."

Kricket transferred to UW Oshkosh and then Marquette University School of Dentistry, where she graduated as a dentist. Alex transferred back to Michigan Tech, where he graduated in mechanical engineering technology. Alex says, "There are a lot of great things that came from Nicolet, and I felt like it set me up to succeed again at Michigan Tech because I kind of regained some confidence that I lost after that first year."

Kricket and Alex both agree that the quality of their education here at Nicolet College was top notch. "The best math and English instructors I've had were here at Nicolet," Alex says.

In 2019, Kricket purchased Northwoods Family Dental, the dental practice that she actually

worked at when she was a student. Alex is currently the product validation lead at Superior Diesel. That same year they also got married.

To this day, Kricket and Alex believe Nicolet College and the Nicolet College Foundation gave them the foundation on which their success is built. Alex adds, "I cannot tell the story of my life and working career up to this point without including Nicolet and all the support I received while I was here. It was such an important part of my journey."

Kricket says, "I don't know that I would have been able to go to Marquette or to be able to afford to have a dental practice because of the amount of student debt that I incurred when I was at Marquette. I don't know if it would have been possible unless I started here."

Kricket and Alex are proof of the transformative power of education, and through physics and speech classes, they each found a lifelong partner. It all started here, at Nicolet College.

Dr. Kricket Koehn received the 2022 Wisconsin Technical College System District Boards Association Distinguished Alumni Award. She says, "Beginning my education at

Family Legacy

The Mendham family's connection to Nicolet College dates back to the very beginning, more than 50 years ago, when Nicolet College was first opening. Dick remembers, "One day I got a call from President Richard Brown and Dr. Steger, and they asked if they could interview me, and they said they were looking for someone to work in the hospitality program. We didn't have a college out here at that point." Dick's education and experience running Sunrise Lodge with his wife Elsie in Land O' Lakes made him a perfect fit to start what is now the Culinary Arts program.

Dick worked at Nicolet College for ten years and has been a Foundation donor since the 1970s. "It's a great way to support the College and the future students and the future people getting into that field." The Mendhams have made their philanthropic decisions together, and Elsie says, "It's worth helping other people. It's a good thing to do."

Vicki, one of Dick and Elsie's daughters, has always had a passion for cooking, but she didn't always see herself using that passion in the classroom. Her dad talked her into teaching one class. Vicki remembers going into this thinking, "One class can't hurt me! I'll try it out and see how I like it, and that was 28 years ago."


As a full-time Culinary Arts instructor, Vicki takes her role in helping to train current and future employees seriously. "Right now restaurants need employees, they need trained employees, and that's always going to be part of the Northwoods. We try to change with the times and add new classes," Vicki says.

As an employee and donor, Vicki also serves as chairperson of the Nicolet College Foundation Employee Giving Campaign, saying, "I can see in the classroom how that helps our students succeed. Sometimes just a little scholarship is the difference between them continuing on and not continuing on."

Nicolet College will always be a big part of the Mendham family. "My dad started here a long time ago and we took classes here. My daughter's taken classes here. My sister taught here, my mom taught some classes here. It's part of the family. From as far back as I can remember, we've been at Nicolet."

Their ties to Nicolet College will continue long into the future. Vicki's daughter Kayla is already a donor, saying, "My mom has actually always encouraged me to donate to the Foundation. Just knowing that we can help people to really live their dreams and get the most out of the experience that they can. I'm just really proud of my grandpa, grandma, and my mom for giving some hope to people."


