Emergency Financial Assistance - Apply for emergency assistance including the Student Success, Student Support, and Emergency Assistance Program, Gift Cards, or Technology Assistance.

conditions' box.

11. You can accept or decline the offer. If you select 'Decline All', it only pertains

to loans - grants & scholarships are automatically accepted.
