10. <u>PRESIDENT FOY – REMARKS</u> – Dr. Foy briefed the Board on behalf of the WTCS state office and her WTCS Tours of Excellence.

11. <u>Board Policy Review</u> – *BP 2, Part 1, Review Team Status Update: Trustee Melinda Young briefed the Board on the final updates.

MOTION: THAT THE NICOLET COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ACCEPT THE REVISIONS AS PRESENTED FOR BP 2.01, BP 2.02, BP 2.05, BP 2.06, BP 2.08, BP 2.12, AND BP 2.03 (WITH THE AMENDED LANGUAGE: "THE CHAIR SHALL ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH ALL REQUIRED DUTIES IMPOSED BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO" AND "THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL APPOINT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO REPRESENT THE COLLEGE IN THE WISCONSIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARDS ASSOCIATION." MARTINI MADE A MOTION, SECONDED BY EGAN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY ON A VOICE VOTE.

*Overall update: Chair Lazear updated the launch of Board Policy review team BP 2, Group 2. Team members: Dall, Salzer, Lazear, Ferrel, and Peeters.

12. <u>Innovation and Sustainability</u> – Chair Lazear discussed ways to support college efforts to move more aggressively forward on initiatives and new program plans. Possible action taken on discussion.

MOTION(S):

SUSTAINABILITY. THAT THE NICOLET COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES REQUESTS THAT THE PRESIDENT DEVELOP A WATER MANAGEMENT THAT IS CARRIED THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING PLAN (CURRENTLY UNDER DEVELOPMENT IN RESPONSE TO BP 2.12); THE FACILITIES PLAN (AND ALL FUTURE ITERATIONS); AND IS CONSIDERED IN ANY PROJECT UNDERTAKEN. THE PLAN SHOULD HAVE ELEMENTS THAT ARE ABLE TO BE IMPLEMENTED IN THE SHORT TERM (THE NEXT (6 MONTHS AS PART OF THIS BUDGET YEAR), INTERMEDIATE TERM (THE NEXT YEAR, THE UPCOMING BUDGET YEAR) AND LONG TERM (NEXT 2-4 YEARS).

THE BOARD REQUESTS THAT THE PRESIDENT DEVELOP A PHASED PLAN THAT REFLECTS THE COLLEGE'S COMMITMENT TO ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY ON THE FIELD IN THE FRONT OF THE COLLEGE. THE PLAN SHOULD HAVE ELEMENTS THAT CAN BE IMPLEMENTED IN THE SPRING 2024, WITH AN ADAPTIVE MANAGEMENT APPROACH THAT CAN START WITH NO OR LOW-COST CHANGES AND ARE REVERSABLE, THEN INCORPORATE ANY ADDITIONAL PLANS AND COST IN THE FACILITIES PLAN AND BUDGET FOR THE UPCOMING YEAR(S). THE PRESIDENT WILL UPDATE THE BOARD ON THE PROGRESS REGULARLY. MARTINI MADE THE MOTION, SECONDED BY EGAN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY ON A VOICE VOTE.

INNOVATION. THAT THE NICOLET COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES REQUESTS THAT THE PRESIDENT INCREASE THE CAPACITY OF THE COLLEGE TO ENCOURAGE, SUPPORT, REWARD AND IMPLEMENT INNOVATION.

MARTINI MADE THE MOTION TO CHARGE THE PRESIDENT WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND INNOVATION WORK AS STATED SECONDED BY EGAN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY ON A VOICE VOTE.
